- Supportive learning environment: Availability of assistive technologies, study materials, and human assistance facilitates better academic engagement.
- Improved student welfare: Counselling, guidance, and career support help students with disabilities make informed decisions and secure employment.
- Awareness and sensitization: Training programs for faculty and staff foster an inclusive and non-discriminatory campus culture.
- Institutional support system: Establishment of an expert committee ensures grievance redressal, policy implementation, and continuous improvement.
- Financial and policy support: Scholarships, concessions, and adherence to government regulations enhance opportunities and reduce barriers.
- Digital accessibility: Compliance with web accessibility standards ensures equal access to online resources and services.

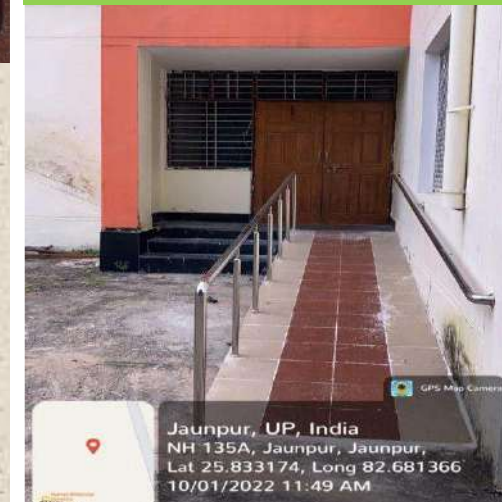

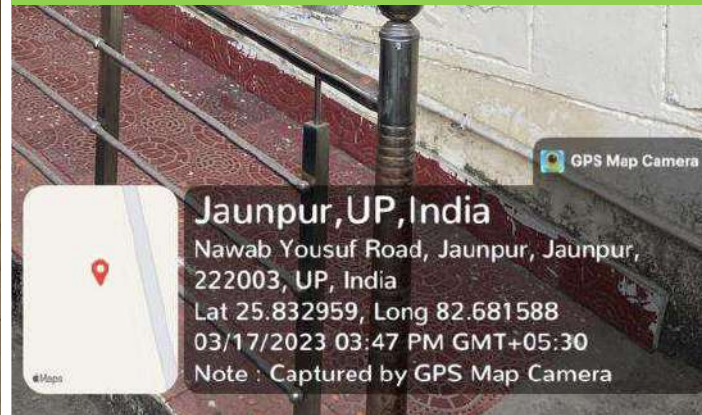

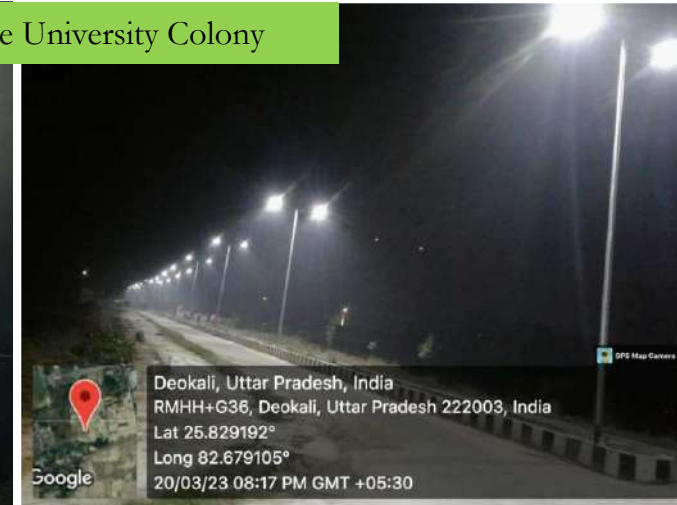
