I am enclosing herewith a softcopy of Ph.D. scholars details in PDF format on prescribed proforma provided by UGC, New Delhi.


Kindly treat this mail as an urgent matter as it has already too late failing which may result into black listing of our university and will be declared as fake university on UGC website.

As per clause 5.6 of the "University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016" notified in the Gazette of India on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2016, the University shall maintain the list of all the M.Phill/Ph.D. registered students including name of the registered candidate, topic of his/her research, name of supervisor/cosupervisor, date of enrolment/registration on its website on year-wise basis.
