Code of Ethics for Research

Maintaining research ethics is of paramount importance in academic institutions and **Veer Bahadur Singh Purvanchal University (VBSPU)** believe that faculty members, researchers, scientists, and students entail a commitment to the advancement of research. VBSPU firmly believes in following ethics and honesty in research and maintaining high honesty, transparency, and accountability in research. Hence several measures are established for the prevention of research misconduct failing which would evoke disciplinary actions at various levels.

The Code of Research Ethics determines the basic research ethical standards for faculty members, researchers/scientists, students, and all other stakeholders at the University. VBSPU lays down a code of ethics for research and researchers, which provides guidelines for the responsible conduct of ethical research with the following **objectives**:

1. To ensure that all research activity undertaken by VBSPU complies with agreed national/international ethical standards.
2. To promote and inspire researchers to undertake basic and applied research activities which have national and international importance.

Good Research Practices:

Laboratory Records:

It is mandatory to maintain proper records of data from each research project whether it is questionnaire-based or experimental research. These records are the property of respective laboratory and university.

Collaborative studies:

In the case of collaborative research, benefits (both in material and publication/patent) of the research should be decided before to starting the research, should be accepted by each collaborator, and well recorded.

Authorship:

It is mandatory for all researchers/scientists to disseminate the research results in an open, transparent, honest, and accurate manner. The University expects all publications to conform to appropriate discipline-specific professional standards. In the multi-authored publications, the

contribution of each author should be mentioned in the manuscript. Any individual, who has not made an intellectual contribution to any particular research project should not be included as an author of the publication derived from that research. Ghost and honorary authorships come under research misconduct and unethical practice and should not be encouraged. In each publication, acknowledgment of the funding agency and declaration of Conflict of Interest (COI) is mandatory. In addition, the contribution of each author should also be mentioned.

Plagiarism:

All research works of the students such as assignments, project reports, and dissertations should be free from plagiarism. In the manuscript, the author/authors should provide a disclosure statement that he/she did not copy any paragraph/sentences from previously published research work either from his/her own (self-plagiarism) or from other researcher's published information. University has subscribed to plagiarism checker software (Ouriginal) and each faculty member has free access. Every thesis/manuscript/dissertation has to be checked by Ouriginal software before submission. Researchers should report data collection methods; analyses and interpretation of results transparently and honestly.

Research on humans and human biological materials:

All research projects involving human tissue should be cleared by the Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC) of the University, which is constituted according to the guidelines of the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR). Informed written consent from each participant is necessary before the collection of human samples (blood/tissue).

Use of animals in research:

The guidelines on rules and regulations of the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (MoEFCC), India should be followed by the researchers using the animal in their experiments. The animal houses should comply with the best possible standards of hygiene and upkeep. Every researcher has to take permission from Institution's Animal Ethics Committee before starting the experiments.

Working with Chemicals:

Every researcher/scientist/student have to follow the recommendations of the Bureau of Indian Standards, Govt. of India for the code of safety for laboratory chemicals.

Radiation Safety:

In the case of working with radiation sources (radioisotopes etc.), researchers have to follow the guidelines set by the Department of Atomic Energy, Govt. of India. Close monitoring

by the Institution Research Ethics committee is necessary to monitor regularly the risk of radiation.

Definition of Research Misconduct:

Research misconduct includes not only plagiarism, falsification, and fabrication, falsification, but also includes deception of methodology, data, and negative results and failure to follow a protocol and negligence in following biosafety guidelines, etc.

Research misconduct may be categorized into the following:

- **Plagiarism:** Plagiarism includes the use of results, data, and language of other's published work without giving credit /citation. Even the use of data, results, and paraphrasing of own published articles also comes under the category of plagiarism i.e. self- plagiarism.
- **Embezzlement of ideas:** Without proper citation, using the ideas of other researchers obtained from access while manuscript reviewing, grant proposal reviewing and discussion, etc. also a category of research misconduct.
- **Falsification: Addition/ deletion/ misrepresentation** of a part of data to generate positive results to present a misleading outcome.
- **Fabrication:** Reporting 'results' of experiments that were never done. This also includes images/ photographs being morphed to reach a particular interpretation. Inclusion of data/information in research publications, thesis, and dissertation reports without performing any experiments
- **Fraud:** Deliberately highlighting results of own research and avoiding inclusion of other researcher's results which are contrary to present results.
- **Non-compliance of Regulatory Guidelines:** Intentional avoidance of the ethical guidelines of human (IEC/ICMR) and animal (MoEFCC) research and also violations of biosafety regulations.
- **Inappropriate Authorship:** Supervisors are not giving proper credit to students and inclusion of non-contributing individuals as a ghost and honorary authors in the manuscript.
- **Withholding data from Validation:** Researchers hide facts/data and methodology and do not provide data or research materials to the university/journal for verification/validation purposes.

Curbing research misconduct:

All the faculty members/ researchers/scientists/students at VBSPU are expected to follow the Code of Ethics of research as described in this policy. University has taken several measures to curb research misconduct:

- **University subscription of plagiarism checking software:** University has subscribed the plagiarism -checking software named ouriginal.
- **Mandatory plagiarism checking:** Each student must get performed for submitting the project report/dissertation/ research paper to the University/ or any journal publication house.
- **Mandatory Similarity Check of thesis submission:** The similarity check is also performed on the theses submitted to the University and uploaded on Shodhganga to curb plagiarism.

➤ **Responsibilities of Researchers:**

University has also set few responsibilities to the researchers, and the researcher

- should be aware of and adhere to the code of research ethics,
 - should employ appropriate research methodology,
 - should keep proper and accurate records of all research/experiments/data,
 - should disseminate research findings,
 - should take responsibility for their contributions to all publications, funding applications, reports, and other representations of their research,
 - should mention the contributions of each author in publication,
 - should disclose clearly financial and other conflicts of interest, and
 - should report to the appropriate authorities about any suspected research misconduct, including fabrication, falsification or plagiarism, and other irresponsible research practices.
- **Institution Research Ethics Committee:** University has constituted an Institution Research Ethics Committee to look after the implementation of the code of research ethics in the university and affiliating colleges. Responsibilities of the Research Ethics Committee are:
- To promote research excellence and integrity

- to provide advice and guidance to the VBSPU academic community on all matters of research ethics
- to provide guidance and academic support to researchers/Scientists/students on ethical issues in respect of research and other academic activities.
- to act as an investigative/consultative body for any disputed matter concerning research ethics and conduct

Dealing with Misconduct:

The Institution Research Ethics Committee, (IREC) would be set by the Vice Chancellor of the University comprising eminent researcher as chairman from the University and assistant registrar (Academic) as member secretary and at least one external expert. Research misconduct shall be reported to the IREC, which will enquire and take appropriate action against the offending researchers.

Levels of Violations of Good Academic Practice


Two levels of violations of good academic practice can be distinguished.

1. Minor Violations:

Such violations may present no risks to subjects, the wider community, or the environment, but they may warrant some penalty or sanction at the institutional level.

2. Major Violations:

The level of violation of research integrity is deliberate, such as negligence in handling human and animal samples, more than 20% of plagiarism, fabrication and falsification of data, etc.





To accelerate the growth, it is decided to reward its most productive researchers with handsome incentives, to increase the research outcome, the number of publications and patents as well as expand its research infrastructure.

The V B S Purvanchal University, Research and Development policy has been modified with the following objectives.

- To create, strengthen and maintain state-of- the-art research infrastructure in the V B S Purvanchal University campus to facilitate cutting-edge research activity.
- To facilitate inter and multi- disciplinary research
- To recognize both faculty and students on their research output by a research award
- To set up incubation facilities to promote innovation, entrepreneurship and encourage startups.
- To integrate research activities with the thrust areas of research of the university which are drawn keeping in view the local, regional and national needs, present and future, and also sustainable development goals (SDGs).
- To translate new knowledge, technology, innovations emerging out of the research at University into products, processes and services for benefit of the society.
- Protection of Intellectual Property Right (IPR) arising out of the research conducted by the university fraternity.
- To create quality human resources for scientific research

Custodian of the Policy:

The implementation and updating of Research Policy shall be carried out by a **Research Advisory Board**, constituted by Honourable Vice Chancellor. Research Advisory Board will advise and supervise research related matters of the university.

Research and Development Support Schemes for promotion of research environment in the campus/University:

(a) Research Award

V B S Purvanchal University recognizes the research carried out by its faculty members by granting "**Best Research Awards**" (Three awards/year) for publishing papers, contribution to h-index of the university, through funded projects, and patents. Under this scheme, scholars will get a certificate of appreciation (CoA). The screening for best research award will be made by

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Research Advisory Committee on the basis of number of papers published and highest SCI impact factor score etc.

(b) Financial Support for Journal Publications :

Partial financial support is given to faculty members who like to publish their work in Open Access and peer reviewed journals with impact factor (SCI journals).

- Financial support for the open access fee is open to all the faculty members of V B S Purvanchal University guiding full-time research scholars.
- Only quality open access journals with impact factor will be considered. Journals with no impact factor will not be considered.
- The decision to support open access journal fee will be decided by Research Advisory Committee.
- Once the paper is accepted, the faculty shall submit the application along with copy of the research paper and invoice to the Research Advisory Committee for the financial support.
- Once the article is published, the copy of the published article and payment receipt should be submitted to the office of Research Advisory Committee, AR- academics and Finance section.

(c) Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF)

Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) is initiated to enhance the research and innovation ecosystem of University by attracting young talented scientists with a diverse background to work on challenging and frontier areas. It provides a platform for the development of future science and technology leaders.

- The duration of the fellowship will be initially for a period of 1 year, extended for 2nd and 3rd year on satisfactory performance of the PDF scholar in the half-yearly review meeting.
- There is no provision for providing manpower support under this scheme. The PDF scholar is expected to undertake the research objectives by himself/herself during the entire duration of the fellowship. The PDF scholar will be reporting to the mentor/Head of the department. The PDF scholars are not eligible to receive any other fellowship from any Government or Non-Governmental source during the tenure of the fellowship.
- If any PDF scholar wishes to terminate the fellowship, he/she shall inform the mentor and Head of department giving one month notice. If the candidate wants to quit before 6 months, he/she should repay 50% of stipend received till that date. University reserves the right to terminate the Fellowship at any stage if it is convinced that appropriate progress is not being made or the grant has not been utilized properly.

(d) Financial Support for Research Paper Presentation in National and International Conferences/ Seminars

Faculty members are eligible to get financial assistance up to Rs. 20,000/- per annum for attending National conference/seminar organized in India. For international conferences organized out of India, faculty members are eligible to get financial assistance up to Rs.1,00,000/- per annum. Financial Support Claim can be made once in two years by a faculty

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member. The selection of the faculty for financial support for paper presentation will be made by Research Advisory Committee.

A faculty member can seek reimbursement only if he/she is a presenter/first author, provided no other agency had given financial help for the same. A faculty is not eligible for reimbursement, for just chairing a session or attending the conference.

(e) Translation of research articles published in reputed journal

Research articles published in reputed journals by the faculty members should be translated in Hindi and University should allocate grants for the translation of research article translation.

(f) Minor Research Project (MRP) for Faculty Members

To promote the research environment in the University campus, the V B S Purvanchal University will provide financial assistance as Minor Research Project to teachers. This scheme will provide research support to faculty members of the University to undertake research and encourage Research Culture among teachers so as to equip them to take up challenging research activities in future career

- The maximum research grant for one project will amount up to INR 3,00,000 (Rs three lakh only).
- Project proposal should be forwarded by the Head of Department of the concerned department.
- An applicant is eligible to apply only one proposal during a call.
- Project is not transferable in any case.
- The Project period is one year from the date of sanction. If the proposed project would not be completed, an extension for completion of research project, without financial assistance may be given to Investigator on written request subject to a maximum of one year.
- No request for additional grant in excess of the sanctioned budget will be considered.
- Project is expected to be conducted by the faculty member himself or herself. Hence no manpower would be supported in the Grant.
- All research projects submitted to be properly scrutinized by a screening committee before funds are released. After finalisation of the selection procedure of the Research projects the names of the selected Investigators will be uploaded on the University website.
- Proposals submitted must be original in idea and content. Plagiarism in any form will not be acceptable and proposals are liable to be rejected if found plagiarized.. The principal investigator will be solely responsible for the issues related to copyright and/or plagiarism of the information used in the research project.
- The Investigator has to commence the project within one month from the date of award letter
- Any proposal rejected should not be resubmitted without any substantial revision.
- A midterm evaluation of the sanctioned project will be done by the Committee, constituted by Honorable Vice Chancellor and the Investigator will have to submit and present the midterm progress reports before the committee.





- It is expected that the grantee shall submit the midterm report (after six months), final progress report (report of the research done), and utilization certificate to the IQAC through Dean/Head of Department. The Investigators are expected to settle the accounts immediately on completion of the project.
- The unutilized grant if any, may be refunded immediately through demand draft drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, VBS Purvanchal University, Jaunpur.
- If any Investigator fails to complete the project, he/she has to refund the entire amount released through demand draft drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, VBS Purvanchal University, Jaunpur.
- If the University is not satisfied with the periodical progress of the research project or if it finds that rules are being violated, it reserves the right to terminate its grant for the project and ask for a refund of the amount sanctioned.
- It is mandatory to post the Executive summary of the report, research papers published under Minor Research Project on the website of the University.
- The Investigator shall acknowledge the contribution of University in the research publication of the project.
- University will not be responsible for the fact, opinion, views and findings stated in the project reports.
- Preference would be given to the faculties, who have not any running project.
- A faculty member, who once received a project grant, will be eligible to apply again after a gap of two years from the date of completion of earlier project.
- Compilation of reports of all completed projects reports in the form of a volume for each year should be done by the University.

The University should frequently update its research facilities for smooth functioning of the research projects.

Prevalence of COMT Val158Met polymorphism in Eastern UP population

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Abstract: Catechol-O-methyltransferase (COMT) is an abundant S-adenosylmethionine (SAM)-dependent methyltransferase that methylates catechol compounds, including catecholamines and catechol estrogens. COMT gene located at chromosome 22q11.2 contains a functional polymorphism at codon 158 (Val158Met), which has been related to psychiatric diseases and different types of cancer. COMT might affect they levels because as a by-product it converts SAM to S-adenosylhomocysteine (SAH), which is reversibly converted to homocysteine. The aim of the present study was to determine the frequency of COMT Val158Met polymorphism in scheduled caste (SC) population of Jaunpur district. Total 100 healthy unrelated subjects belonging to SC, between the age group of 18 to 70 years were randomly selected for the present study. 3 ml blood samples were collected from each subject. The inclusion criteria of subjects for present study are that they should be domicile of Uttar Pradesh, and healthy without any individual/ family history of genetic or metabolic disorders. COMT Val158Met polymorphism analysis was done by PCR-RFLP method. The Val/Val genotype was found in 48 subjects, Val/Met in 40 subjects and Met/Met genotype in 12 subjects. Genotype frequencies of Val/Val, Val/Met and Met/Met were 0.48, 0.40 and 0.12 respectively. The allele frequency of Val allele was found to be 0.68 and Met allele frequency was 0.32.

Introduction

Catechol-O-methyltransferase (COMT) is an intracellular methylation enzyme that catalyzes the first step of the dopamine degradation pathway and inactivates catecholamines, which include dopamine, epinephrine, and norepinephrine. It is accepted widely that COMT plays a crucial role in modulating nerve function and physiology, due to its broad distribution throughout the brain and various peripheral tissues. COMT enzyme occurs in two distinct isoforms: a smaller soluble protein in the cytoplasm (S-COMT; 221 aa) and a longer membrane-bound isoform (MB-COMT 271 aa) (1). The MB-COMT is predominantly expressed in brain neurons, while the S-COMT is predominantly expressed in blood cells and tissues like liver and kidney (1).

The COMT gene is located on chromosome 22q11.1-q11.2 and contains six exons. A single base pair change (G471 A) in exon 4 of the COMT gene, at position 472 in the long mRNA, and 322 in the short mRNA, results in an amino acid change (Val→ Met), at codon 158 of MB-COMT and codon 108 of S-COMT, which decreases the activity level of the COMT enzyme 3 to 4 fold (2,3). In addition to being a functional polymorphism, this SNP also creates a polymorphic NlaIII restriction site in the DNA. The two alleles are referred to as Val or COMT*H, or the NlaIII site-absent (G; Val) allele that encodes the thermostable, high activity enzyme and Met or COMT*L, or the NlaIII site-present (A; Met) allele that encodes the thermolabile, low activity enzyme (3,4,5). Presence of a methionine at position 158 decreases the thermostability of COMT

and reduces the activity of the enzyme to 25% of that of the COMT 158-Val enzyme, which leads to diverse changes in cognitive function and human physiology (6). Both the alleles are co-dominant, individuals having Val/Met genotype have an intermediate level of COMT activity in comparison to homozygous (Val/Val) individuals (3). Very limited data about COMT Val158Met mutation frequency are available from Indian population, and no data are available about Uttar Pradesh population; hence, the aim of the present study is to estimate frequency of COMT Val158Met polymorphism in healthy individuals of Eastern Uttar Pradesh.

Materials and Methods

3 ml blood samples were collected from randomly selected 100 unrelated healthy individuals belonging to scheduled caste (SC) population of Eastern Uttar Pradesh belonging to both the genders (50 males and 50 females). All subjects were between the age group of 18-70 years. All subjects gave their informed written consent and the study was approved by the Institutional Ethics Committee of VBS Purvanchal University, Jaunpur. A questionnaire was used to collect demographic information, personal medical history and family history. The inclusion criteria of subjects were- (i) subjects should be domicile of Eastern Uttar Pradesh, (ii) subjects should be belong to scheduled caste, (iii) subjects should be healthy, without any individual/ family history of genetic disorder and (iv) subjects should be unrelated and randomly selected from the Eastern UP population.
