Subject: Guidelines for conducting written examination for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities

The undersigned is directed to say that this Department had issued in guidelines for conducting written examination for persons with disabilities defined in terms of crstwhile Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection too Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 vide OM No. 16-110/2003-DD III and 26/02/2013. The Department had constituted a Committee under the Chairmanship of Secretary, DEPwD in March, 2015 to review the said guidelines based as the mast raised by Union Public Service Commission and others. Meanwhile the Central Povernment embed the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act. 1016 (Rebal) Act. 1016 (Reba

Pased on the findings of the Committee, the Central Government here yes sown the revised guidelines for conducting written examination for persons of benchmark disabilities in supersession of the earlier guidelines issued vide OM 5. 16-110/2003-DD.III dated 26/02/2013 as under:

- These guidelines may be called as "Guidelines for conducting written examination for persons with benchmark disabilities 2018":
- There should be a uniform and comprehensive policy across the country for persons with benchmark disabilities for written/examination taking into account improvement in technology and new avenues opened to the persons with benchmark disabilities providing a level playing field. Policy-should also have flexibility to accommodate the specific needs on case-to-case basis.
- 111. There is no need for fixing separate criteria for regular and competitive examinations.

That the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe as essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon-Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution as per proforma a. APPENDIX-1.

V. The candidate should have the discretion of opting for his own scribe/reader/lab assistant or request the Examination Body for the same. The examining body may also identify the scribe/ reader/lab assistant to make panels at the District/Division/ State level as per the requirements of the examination in such instances the candidates should be allowed to meet the scribe two days before incommination so that the candidates get a chance to check and verify whether the scribe assitable or not.

In case the candidate is allowed to bring his own scribe, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination. The persons with benchmark disabilities opting for own scribe/reader should subtract details of the own scribe as per proforma at APPENDIX-II

VII. There should also be allexibility in accommodating any change is scribe/reader/lab assistant in case of emergency. The candidates should also be allowed to take more than one scribe/reader for writing different papers especially for languages. However, there can be only one scribe per subject.

VIII. Persons with benchmark disabilities should be given as far as possible, the option of choosing the mode for taking the examinations i.e. ii. Braute or in the computer or in large print or even by recording the answers as the examining bodies

The procedure of availing the facility of scribe should be simplified and the necessary details should be recorded at the time of filling up of the forms. Thereafter, the examining body should ensure availability of question papers in the format opted by the candidate as well as suitable seating arrangement for giving examination

VII. The time of giving the question papers should be marked accurately and timely supply of supplementary papers should be ensured
